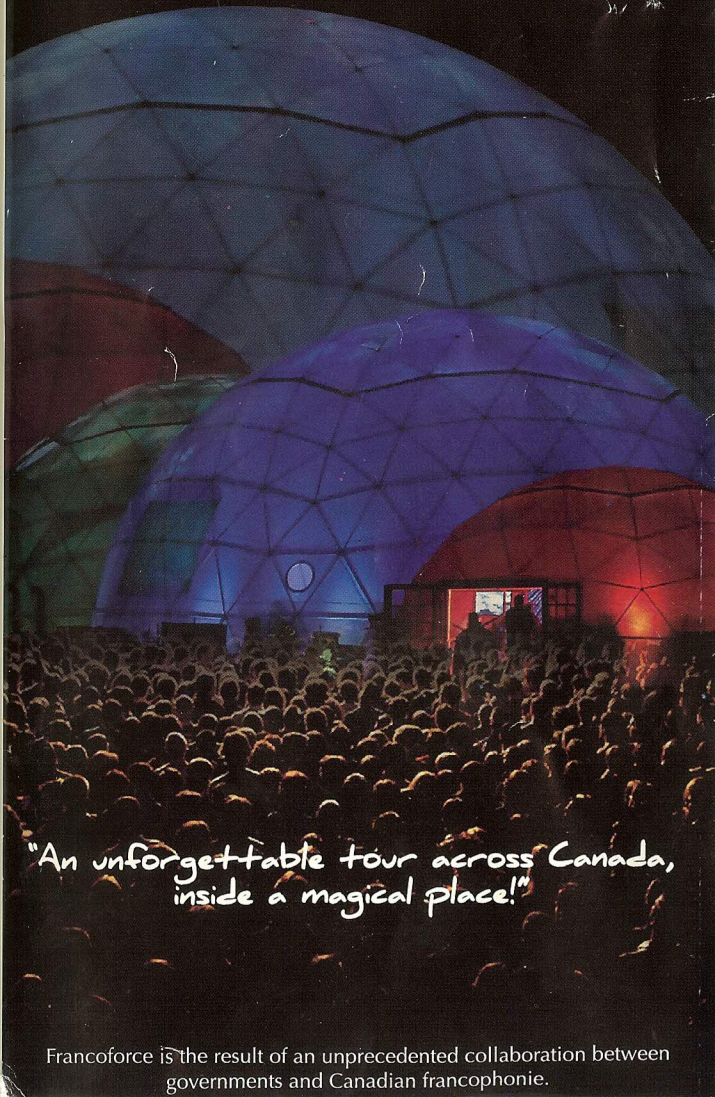

La Grande rencontre

The Francoforce's great performance...An artistic adventure in which song, music, poetry, dance and multimedia come together to celebrate the vitality and diversity of French-Canadian creation... (Reserve your place by getting your pass at the Francoforce site. Admission is free.)

Cercle des créateurs

Using the dome's multimedia capacity, the Cercle des créateurs illustrates the creative process by presenting the works or excerpts of works of the participating artists.

« Beuf » magique

A performance improvised on site that combines the talents of the national Francoforce team and guest creators; a multidisciplinary jamming session that allows for exploration and interactivity between the artists and the audience.

Mots gourmands

A literary celebration wrapped in pastries and chocolate. Writers share their works/excerpts of their work in a gourmet setting.
